- c) Participate in two separate respectful gospel conversations where questions or differing beliefs are discussed without contention; document lessons learned from each. _____
- d) Prepare and teach a 15-minute gospel lesson or devotional to a group (family, quorum, class, or battalion), including scripture use and testimony bearing. _____

- c) Record a final written testimony explaining how sharing the gospel fulfills the Saint's Oath to serve God, family, and country through righteous influence. _____
